In July of 2004, Rabbi Michael R. Zedek began service as the Senior Rabbi of Emanuel Congregation of Chicago. For the previous four years, Rabbi Zedek was the Chief Executive Officer of the Jewish Federation of Cincinnati. Prior to accepting that appointment, he served for 26 years as the spiritual leader of Congregation B'nai Jehudah in Kansas City, Missouri, where he holds the title of Rabbi Emeritus.

He has taught and lectured in South Africa, Russia, China, the former Yugoslavia, Israel and in many other venues. Rabbi Zedek also serves as the host of a radio show, Religion on the Line.
